**AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYERS AND NOTICE OF AVAILABLE
FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2010*) Each employer shall post
2 in a conspicuous place a notice of the availability of earned income
3 credit allowable under Section 32 of the Internal Revenue Code of
4 1986, or any subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the
5 United States, as from time to time amended, in such form and manner
6 as the Labor Commissioner determines. For the purposes of this
7 section, "employer" means a person engaged in business who has
8 employees, including the state and any political subdivision thereof.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
