**AN ACT CONCERNING OUT-OF-STATE EMPLOYMENT OF  
CONNECTICUT MINORS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10-193 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) The superintendent of schools of any local or regional board of  
4 education or an agent designated by such superintendent shall, upon  
5 application and in accordance with procedures established by the State  
6 Board of Education, furnish, to any person desiring to employ a minor  
7 under the age of eighteen years, whether in state or out of state (1) in  
8 any manufacturing, mechanical or theatrical industry, restaurant or  
9 public dining room, or in any bowling alley, shoe-shining  
10 establishment or barber shop, a certificate showing that such minor is  
11 sixteen years of age or older, (2) in any mercantile establishment, a  
12 certificate showing that such minor is fifteen years of age or older, and  
13 (3) at any municipal or private golf course, a certificate showing that  
14 such minor is fourteen years of age or older.

15 (b) The State Board of Education shall establish procedures

16 governing the issuance of such certificates.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow Connecticut minors, who are eligible to work and reside in state border towns, to gain employment in the bordering state.
