**AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK OF
YOUTH CAMP EMPLOYEES AND VOLUNTEERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) Each youth camp
2 licensed pursuant to chapter 368r of the general statutes shall require
3 every person (1) employed by the camp, (2) volunteering at the camp,
4 (3) applying for a paid or volunteer position at the camp, and (4)
5 affiliated with the camp who is responsible for transporting in a motor
6 vehicle any child attending the camp to submit to a state and national
7 criminal history records check in accordance with section 29-17a of the
8 general statutes.

9 (b) The cost of the state and national criminal history records check
10 required under subsection (a) of this section shall be paid by the youth
11 camp.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
