**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MANDATED REPORTING OF THE
PREGNANCY OF A MINOR AGE TWELVE YEARS OR YOUNGER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 17a-101b of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 a mandated reporter to immediately notify the Department of
- 3 Children and Families and a local law enforcement agency, and for
- 4 said department and such agency to immediately respond to this
- 5 notification, when a minor age twelve years or younger is seeking to
- 6 terminate a pregnancy.

Statement of Purpose:

To require immediate intervention when, as evidenced by her pregnancy, a minor girl age twelve years or younger has been the victim of sexual assault.
