**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A JOB SHADOWING PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS AGE SIXTEEN YEARS AND OLDER.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Education to establish a job shadowing program for any student age
- 3 sixteen years or older who seeks job shadowing experience in the
- 4 industries of construction and manufacturing, provided such student
- 5 is not enrolled in a state-sponsored job training program.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To allow students age sixteen years and older to job shadow in the industries of construction and manufacturing.
