AN ACT CONCERNING STATE LAND WHERE HUNTING IS PERMITTED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit the Department of
- 2 Environmental Protection from reducing the amount of state land
- 3 where hunting is permitted without providing for an equal amount of
- 4 such land elsewhere and that such amount of land not be less than the
- 5 percentage of state land permitted for hunting as of July 1, 2008.

Statement of Purpose:

To maintain the amount of state land where hunting is permitted.
