**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE, SALE OR MARKETING OF  
MEXICAN SALVIA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 2 use, sale or marketing of Mexican Salvia.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To protect state residents, particularly children, by prohibiting the use, sale or marketing of Mexican Salvia, a plant that can be used a hallucinogenic substance.
