AN ACT CONCERNING RENTAL ASSISTANCE FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES LIVING IN SHELTERS IN THE CITIES OF NEW HAVEN AND HARTFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 319uu of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Commissioner of Social Services to set aside fifty rental assistance
- 3 program certificates for homeless families currently living in shelters
- 4 in the city of New Haven and fifty rental assistance program
- 5 certificates for homeless families currently living in shelters in the city
- 6 of Hartford.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide stability for the families that have fallen upon hard times and find themselves homeless and staying in shelters.
