AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPOUNDMENT OF VEHICLES USED FOR ILLEGAL STREET RACING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that any person
- 2 who violates subsection (c) of section 14-224 of the general statutes
- 3 shall have the vehicle such person was operating at the time of such
- 4 violation impounded for a period of thirty days, and such person shall
- 5 pay any fees associated with such impoundment.

Statement of Purpose:

To discourage illegal street racing by providing that anyone who commits illegal street racing shall have his or her vehicle impounded for thirty days and pay the cost of such impoundment.
