**AN ACT CONCERNING HEATING SYSTEM REPLACEMENTS FOR
SCHOOLS IN TOLLAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That, notwithstanding the provisions of section 10-283 of the general
2 statutes or any regulation adopted by the State Board of Education
3 pursuant to said section 10-283 concerning ineligible costs, the town of
4 Tolland shall be eligible to receive a grant for the costs of replacing
5 heating systems at Tolland Middle School, Parker Memorial School
6 and Annex Building, provided the school district files an application
7 for such project no later than June 30, 2010, and meets all other
8 provisions of chapter 173 of the general statutes and any regulation
9 adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to said chapter 173,
10 and that, notwithstanding the provisions of section 10-286 of the
11 general statutes or any regulation adopted by the State Board of
12 Education setting square footage specifications for purposes of
13 calculating eligible costs for a school building project grant, such
14 square footage specifications shall not apply to said projects.

Statement of Purpose:

To make the cost of replacing the current school heating system with a geothermal heating system eligible for reimbursement from school construction grants.
