AN ACT CONCERNING A TAX CREDIT TO PROVIDE PROPERTY TAX RELIEF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to provide certain taxpayers
2 with a tax credit against their state income tax in an amount, for
3 homeowners, of up to four thousand dollars and, for motor vehicle
4 owners, of up to four hundred dollars. Such credit shall not exceed
5 fifty per cent of the total property or motor vehicle tax liability and
6 may be taken on either the real property or motor vehicle tax bill. Such
7 credit shall be available only to taxpayers residing in any consolidated
8 city and town which (1) was consolidated in 1896, (2) has a mayor and
9 common council form of government, and (3) a population of more
10 than one hundred thousand.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide property tax relief to the homeowners and automobile owners who face the highest tax burden in the state.
