**AN ACT CONCERNING SIMPLIFICATION OF STATE FILING PROCEDURES FOR SMALL BUSINESSES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 12 of the general statutes be amended in various ways to
- 2 reduce paperwork and administrative costs for small businesses and
- 3 increase productivity by (1) providing for depreciation schedules and
- 4 tax filing dates that are the same as in the federal tax code, (2) allowing
- 5 a centralized electronic filing for all business filings with the state,
- 6 including fee and license payments, and (3) allowing personal
- 7 property of a small business to be deleted from its personal property
- 8 register five years after the date of its acquisition.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reduce paperwork and increase productivity of small businesses.
