AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC PROJECTS AND THE STATE FLOWER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) On and after the effective
2 date of this section, whenever a contract is entered into for the
3 construction, reconstruction or remodeling of any state building, as
4 defined in section 4b-53 of the general statutes, and as part of such
5 contract or a subcontract thereto, plantings will be installed, not less
6 than one-fifth of such plantings shall consist of the state flower, the
7 mountain laurel, *Kalmia latifolia*.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
