**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF SEIZED CONTROLLED  
SUBSTANCES AND DRUGS FOR TRAINING NARCOTIC DETECTION  
CANINES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 21a-262 of the general statutes be amended to permit
- 2 the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to transfer seized controlled
- 3 drugs or substances to businesses that train narcotic detection canines
- 4 for training purposes.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To permit the transfer of seized controlled drugs or substances to businesses that train narcotic detection canines for training purposes at no charge.
