**AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY FOR AGED, BLIND
AND DISABLED ADULTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 319v of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Social Services, in accordance with existing federal
- 3 law, to file an amendment to the Medicaid state plan to allow the
- 4 commissioner, when making Medicaid eligibility determinations, to
- 5 establish and maintain the income limit for persons who are aged,
- 6 blind or disabled at the same income level used to determine eligibility
- 7 for all other adults.

Statement of Purpose:

To make the Medicaid income limit for aged, blind and disabled adults
the same as for all other adults.
