**AN ACT CONCERNING LEED-NEW CONSTRUCTION AND LEED-EXISTING BUILDING ACCREDITED PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 regional community-technical colleges to work with the Institute of
- 3 Sustainable Energy at Eastern Connecticut State University and the
- 4 Connecticut Green Building Council to develop certification programs
- 5 to prepare every student in construction-related programs for LEED-
- 6 New Construction and LEED-Existing Building Accredited
- 7 Professional certificates by 2010.
