**AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF TERRITORIAL RATING FOR  
AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 38a-686 of the general statutes be amended to reduce
- 2 the weight of individual territorial loss cost data for territorial
- 3 experience in determining automobile liability insurance policy rates
- 4 in this state from seventy-five per cent to sixty-five per cent.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To reduce the weight of individual territorial loss cost data for territorial experience in determining automobile insurance rates in this state to create equitable rates for defined territories.
