**AN ACT CONCERNING AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY INSURANCE
COVERAGE AND GUIDE DOGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 700 of the general statutes be amended to specify that a
- 2 guide dog is deemed to be tangible property for the purposes of
- 3 automobile liability insurance policies, and if a guide dog is injured or
- 4 killed by an insured motor vehicle, such injury or destruction shall be
- 5 compensable to the owner of such guide dog under the property
- 6 damage provision of such policy.

Statement of Purpose:

To require automobile insurers to pay for expenses arising from the injury or destruction of a guide dog by an insured motor vehicle.
