***AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF RESIDENTIAL DOCKS
BY HARBOR MANAGEMENT COMMISSIONS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 22a-113l of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) Any commission established pursuant to section 22a-113k [is
4 authorized to] may enter into contracts, employ consultants and other
5 assistants and receive and expend funds for equipment, supplies and
6 staff to carry out the purposes of section 15-1, subsection (a) of section
7 15-7 and sections 22a-113k to 22a-113t, inclusive. Any municipality
8 may appropriate funds to such commission.

9 (b) Any such commission may, in consultation with the
10 Commissioner of Environmental Protection, develop and implement
11 standards and criteria for the design, construction and location of
12 residential docks along the waterfront of the member municipality.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
