**AN ACT BANNING CERTAIN CHILDREN'S PRODUCTS CONTAINING  
BISPHENOL-A.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 420d of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the
- 2 sale of any children's product (1) containing bisphenol-A, and (2)
- 3 intended for use by children age three or younger.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit the sale of children's products intended for children age three or younger that contain bisphenol-A.
