AN ACT CONCERNING THE ALLOCATION OF CERTAIN BOATING FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 268 of the general statutes be amended to increase
- 2 boating fees payable to harbormasters by ten per cent and to redirect
- 3 such increase to shoreline towns and to towns located on rivers that
- 4 empty into Long Island Sound.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that revenue from certain boating fees be directed to towns that bear the most burden.
