**AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLES ON MUNICIPAL LAND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to authorize municipalities to
- 2 impose fines, not to exceed one hundred dollars, for the unauthorized
- 3 operation of all-terrain vehicles on municipal land, to permit
- 4 municipalities to impound such vehicles for second and subsequent
- 5 violations and, where a violator is under the age of sixteen, to impose
- 6 such penalties on said violator's parents.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize municipalities to impose fines, not to exceed one hundred dollars, for the unauthorized operation of all-terrain vehicles on municipal land, to permit municipalities to impound such vehicles for second and subsequent violations and, where a violator is under the age of sixteen, to impose such penalties on said violator's parents.
