AN ACT CONCERNING POLICE TRAINING IN IMMIGRATION LAW ENFORCEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that each police
- 2 basic or review training program conducted or administered by the
- 3 Police Officer Standards and Training Council established under
- 4 section 7-294b of the general statutes include the distribution of
- 5 materials created by the federal Immigration and Customs
- 6 Enforcement agency concerning the appropriate procedure for
- 7 enforcing immigration law.

Statement of Purpose:

To require police training to include materials created by the federal Immigration and Customs Enforcement agency concerning immigration law enforcement.
