**AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH CARE INSTITUTIONS FROM
DISPOSING MEDICATIONS INTO THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368v of the general statutes be amended to prohibit
- 2 any health care institution from disposing of unused or expired
- 3 medications by placing such medications directly or indirectly into the
- 4 public water supply.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent health care institutions from disposing medications into the public water supply so as to promote the health, safety and well-being of state residents.
