***AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS
AS AN IDENTIFIER ON MEDICAL RECORDS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to adopt regulations requiring that all
- 3 licensed health care providers and facilities in the state eliminate the
- 4 use of Social Security numbers as an identifier on medical records and
- 5 that medical industry identity codes shall be used in lieu of Social
- 6 Security numbers on such records.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the use of Social Security numbers as an identifier on medical records.
