**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
CONNECTICUT RESTROOM ACT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that retail
- 2 establishments that provide toilet facilities to three or more employees
- 3 shall permit retail customers, who are in possession of documentation
- 4 that establishes that they suffer from prescribed medical conditions,
- 5 access to the employee toilet facilities.

Statement of Purpose:

To implement the Connecticut Restroom Act in order to allow individuals suffering from prescribed medical conditions access to the employee toilet facilities of retail establishments.
