AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF GLUTENS ON THE LABELING OF ALL FOOD PRODUCTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 417 of the general statutes be amended to require any
- 2 entity that is engaged in the preparation and labeling of food products
- 3 in the state ensure that information pertaining to any glutens
- 4 contained in the food product is included on the label of such product.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that any entity in the state that is engaged in the preparation and labeling of food products ensure that information pertaining to any glutens contained in the food product is included on the label of the product.
