**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE FLU
VACCINE TO EMPLOYEES OF LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 368v of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 any employee of a long-term care facility also be subject to the Centers
- 3 for Disease Control and Prevention and Department of Public Health
- 4 guidelines governing the administration of flu vaccines to patients of
- 5 the long-term care facility, including guidelines concerning the ability
- 6 to refuse the administration of the flu vaccine.

Statement of Purpose:

To require employees of long-term care facilities to be subject to guidelines governing the administration of flu vaccines to patients.
