**AN ACT CONCERNING INFORMATIONAL FORUMS ABOUT  
COLLEGE PREPARATION AND ADMISSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-222f of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 local and regional boards of education to require any high school
- 3 under their jurisdiction that hosts an informational forum concerning
- 4 college preparation or the college admission process to which parents
- 5 and guardians of students are invited to provide such parents and
- 6 guardians with information about the optional nature of some surveys
- 7 and questions that accompany examinations taken for college
- 8 admission.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To inform parents and guardians attending informational forums about college preparation and admissions that students are not required to supply certain types of personal identifying information because it may increase a student's vulnerability to identify theft.
