**AN ACT CONCERNING HUMANE EDUCATION AND CONTINUING
EDUCATION FOR TEACHERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 166 and 170 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 require local and regional boards of education to include a humane
- 3 education curriculum as an option for the professional development
- 4 activities for continuing education credit. It is further proposed that
- 5 the costs of such program be borne by the nonprofit sector.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage the inclusion of the principles of humane education in
the continuing education requirements for teachers so that teachers
may then pass along such knowledge to their students in the
classroom.
