AN ACT CONCERNING RESTORATION OF MAGNET SCHOOL FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (25) of section 10-262f of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to revise the definition of "total need students" to eliminate
- 3 the requirement that the number of resident students of a town be
- 4 reduced by one-quarter of the number of resident students of the town
- 5 enrolled in full-time approved interdistrict magnet school programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the ECS reduction for interdistrict magnet school students in sending districts.
