**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CURRICULUM OF VOCATIONAL-
TECHNICAL SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require that
- 2 the curriculum of the vocational-technical schools be modified, with
- 3 the assistance of the Institute for Sustainable Energy and the
- 4 Connecticut Green Building Council, to require students in
- 5 construction-related programs be certified as "LEED for Homes"
- 6 accredited professionals not later than 2010. It is further proposed that
- 7 the curriculum of the vocational-technical schools be modified to
- 8 require students in transportation-related programs be trained in
- 9 alternative fuel vehicle servicing.
