AN ACT CONCERNING MAGNET SCHOOL TUITION FOR HARTFORD STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 the general statutes be amended to require that,
2 notwithstanding subsection (j) of section 10-264l and section 10-264o of
3 the general statutes, the Hartford Board of Education pay no more
4 than the average per pupil tuition in fiscal year 2007-2008 plus an
5 annual increase equal to the Consumer Price Index for each
6 subsequent year for students attending interdistrict magnet schools
7 managed by regional educational service center.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish an annual tuition amount for Hartford students attending magnet schools.
