AN ACT CONCERNING STATE REIMBURSEMENT OF LOCAL SCHOOL REPAIRS AND RENOVATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to change the source of state
- 2 funding for local school repair and renovations from bonding to
- 3 general revenue. Such change would be phased in over ten years, by
- 4 taking the average amount of state reimbursement over the past five
- 5 years and, for each of the next ten years, adding one-tenth of such
- 6 average to the amount reimbursed out of general revenues.

Statement of Purpose:

To move state reimbursement of local school repairs and renovations from bonding to expenditures out of general revenues over a period of ten years.
