**AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED TAX CREDITS TO ALLEVIATE
PROPERTY TAX RATES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That chapter 229 of the general statutes be amended to provide tax
2 credits against the personal income tax for residents and businesses in
3 any consolidated city and town which (1) was consolidated in 1896, (2)
4 has a mayor and common council form of government, and (3) has a
5 population of more than one hundred thousand. Such credits shall be
6 for (A) property taxes paid on homes, provided such credit shall not
7 exceed four thousand dollars or fifty per cent of the total property tax
8 owed, whichever is less, (B) property taxes paid on motor vehicles,
9 provided such credit shall not exceed four hundred dollars or fifty per
10 cent of total property tax owed, whichever is less, and (C) all
11 businesses that are registered with the Department of Administrative
12 Services or the federal Small Business Administration.
