AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF ENTRY FEES OR SERVICE CHARGES FOR CONTESTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner
- 2 of Consumer Protection to amend regulations adopted pursuant to
- 3 section 42-110b of the general statutes to delete the classification of any
- 4 contest or other game promotion that charges an entry fee or service
- 5 charge to enter as an unfair or deceptive practice.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow Connecticut residents to participate in national contests that require entry fees or service charges.
