**AN ACT CONCERNING EFFICIENCY STANDARDS FOR AUTOMATIC
LAWN SPRINKLERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Consumer Protection to adopt regulations
- 3 establishing minimum efficiency standards for automatic lawn
- 4 sprinkler systems, including a requirement that each such system be
- 5 equipped with a moisture sensor device.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote water conservation by requiring automatic lawn sprinklers to be equipped with moisture sensor devices.
