AN ACT CONCERNING THE TREATMENT OF ELEPHANTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) the use of any
- 2 device on an elephant that may be reasonably expected to harm the
- 3 elephant, and (2) the possession of a device that may be used to harm
- 4 an elephant by a person who is in contact with or in possession of an
- 5 elephant.

Statement of Purpose:

To prevent the abuse of elephants.
