**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN INVASIVE
AQUATIC PLANT ERADICATION AND CONTROL PROGRAM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish a new invasive
- 2 aquatic plant eradication and control program to be administered by
- 3 the Department of Environmental Protection and that such program be
- 4 funded by revenue generated by mandatory sales of stickers to be
- 5 affixed to all watercraft used or intended for use in both the inland and
- 6 marine districts.

Statement of Purpose:

To control and eradicate invasive aquatic plants.
