**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMISSIBILITY OF REPORTS
PREPARED BY VETERINARIANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 899 of the general statutes be amended to establish an
- 2 exception to the hearsay rule to allow signed veterinarian records to be
- 3 admitted into evidence without the veterinarian's in-court testimony.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow reports of veterinarians to be admissible into evidence as business entries in certain civil actions in the same manner as medical reports are admitted into evidence.
