**AN ACT CONCERNING FUNDING FOR SUMMER YOUTH
EMPLOYMENT.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the funding to the Labor Department for the summer youth
- 2 employment program be increased to four million dollars and that
- 3 funding be provided in the amount of five hundred thousand dollars
- 4 for the year round employment of eighteen and nineteen-year-olds.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable the workforce boards to hire an adequate number of youth during the summer.
