**AN ACT CONCERNING THE PROCESS FOR APPLYING FOR FILM
TAX CREDITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 12-217jj of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 the Commission on Culture and Tourism to accept applications for
- 3 film tax credits using a film production company's own budget, for
- 4 films with production budgets of less than five hundred thousand
- 5 dollars.

Statement of Purpose:

To make it easier and more economical for smaller film productions to
access the film tax credits by allowing them to submit their own
budgets, rather than the detailed accounting required for larger films.
