**AN ACT REQUIRING SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT ANALYSES FOR PROPOSED REGULATIONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 4 of the general statutes be amended to require state
- 2 agencies to prepare a small business impact analysis for all proposed
- 3 regulations.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require state agencies to perform a small business impact analysis before adopting regulations so the impact of such regulations on small businesses may be meaningfully measured.
