AN ACT CONCERNING THE CROSS-ENDORSEMENT OF CANDIDATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide that whenever any
- 2 candidate is cross-endorsed by two or more parties, such candidate
- 3 shall be considered a member of the political party from whom such
- 4 candidate receives the highest number of votes on the party line for the
- 5 office sought.

Statement of Purpose:

To close a loophole in the treatment of minority party candidates.
