AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF WATER PIPES CONNECTED TO THE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OF SENIOR CITIZENS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require water companies to
- 2 repair or replace as necessary all service pipes and equipment
- 3 connected to residential property to maintain the connection with such
- 4 property at no charge to the owner of such property if (1) such owner
- 5 is over the age of sixty-five, and (2) such property is the primary
- 6 residence of such owner.

Statement of Purpose:

To require water companies to repair or replace service pipes and equipment connected to certain residential property to maintain the connection with such property at no charge to the owner of such property if the owner is over the age of sixty-five.
