**AN ACT CONCERNING THE ACCURACY OF INFORMATION
SUBMITTED BY A PARTY IN A DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE
PROCEEDING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to increase the penalty for any
- 2 party to a dissolution of marriage proceeding who knowingly submits
- 3 false or incomplete information to the court and to allow the court to
- 4 award attorneys' fees and costs against the party who submitted the
- 5 false or incomplete information to the court.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage honesty and integrity in dissolution of marriage proceedings by increasing the sanctions for parties who knowingly provide false or incomplete information to the court.
