**AN ACT CONCERNING COLLECTION OF PAST-DUE CHILD
SUPPORT PAYMENTS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to permit the collection of
- 2 past-due child support payments from a parent who resides in another
- 3 state notwithstanding that the child is eighteen years of age or older.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow for the collection of past-due child support payments from a parent who lives out-of-state despite the fact that the child has reached the age of majority.
