AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO THE AGE OF JUVENILE COURT JURISDICTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to repeal or delay
- 2 implementation of statutory provisions that extend juvenile court
- 3 jurisdiction to sixteen and seventeen-year-old youths.
