**AN ACT CONCERNING SCREENING OF CERTAIN SEXUAL
OFFENDERS FOR PEDOPHILIA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the general statutes be amended to require that persons
2 convicted of crimes sexual in nature involving children under twelve
3 years of age submit to a psychological evaluation to screen for
4 pedophilia; that offenders deemed dangerous shall be eligible for life
5 sentences; and that offenders deemed unlikely to commit a second
6 offense shall qualify for a sentence reduction if they continue
7 psychological evaluation and wear an electronic monitoring device for
8 the duration of the initial sentence.

Statement of Purpose:

To require that persons convicted of crimes sexual in nature involving children under twelve years of age submit to a psychological evaluation to screen for pedophilia.
