***AN ACT CONCERNING PAROLE AND PROBATION TRANSPARENCY.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Correction to notify the chief of police and chief elected official of a
- 3 municipality every thirty days of the names and addresses of the
- 4 persons, if any, released from confinement in a correctional facility into
- 5 that municipality on probation or parole or pursuant to any other
- 6 community release program within the previous thirty days and the
- 7 support and assistance that is being provided to such persons to
- 8 facilitate their reentry into the community.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To give law enforcement and local communities more tools to track ex-offenders who might reoffend and to help community-based organizations identify ex-offenders and assist their reentry into the community.
